FISCAL NOTE

HB 2282 - SB 2699

March 1, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a court-ordered fiduciary or an individual who holds a valid power of attorney that allows them to bring suit on behalf of a person to commence the action on behalf of the person within the applicable statute of limitations. Clarifies that the proposed legislation does not affect the right of a person who regains capacity to bring suit or shield a fiduciary from liability.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will not significantly increase the number of suits brought in court.
- Any impact the courts caseload can be managed within existing resources.
- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact state or local expenditures or operations.
