SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (014951): Requires the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (DMHSAS) to submit a report to the Tennessee General Assembly by February 15 of each year, beginning in 2024, of specified data collected related to the use of medication-assisted treatment for opiate addiction by department-funded providers in Tennessee.
