HB 2397 - SB 2549

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that a person's use of force in self-defense is not justified if the person was engaged in conduct that would constitute in a felony or Class A misdemeanor, rather than an unlawful activity, at the time of the use of force.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any impact to the court system or state or local incarceration resulting from specifying such activity is exempt from justification of self-defense is estimated to be not significant.
