SB 2386 - HB 2475

February 7, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires that driver education courses in public schools include instruction on the dangers of using hand-held mobile telephones or personal digital assistants to transmit or read a message. Requires students be apprised of the consequences for such an act.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:
