SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes Davidson County to construct, operate, and maintain a storm water utility and fund such facility through graduated storm water user fees, if approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the legislative body.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Permissive increases in local expenditures for Davidson County for construction of storm water utility infrastructure will be offset by increases in local revenue from collection of storm water user fees. The extent and timing of such impact cannot reasonably be determined.

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-221-1103 and § 68-221-1107, Davidson County currently has the authority to construct storm water facilities or flood control improvements within its corporate limits and charge graduated storm water user fees to fund such facility.
- Any vote required of the local legislative body will be conducted at a regularly scheduled meeting.
- To the extent the local legislative body approves such a measure, there will be a
 permissive increase in expenditures for Davidson County for construction of such utility;
 however upon construction of such utility, there will be an increase in revenue from
 collection of storm water user fees. The extent and timing of such impact cannot
 reasonably be determined.
