FISCAL NOTE

HB 2569 - SB 2561

SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from once every eight years to once every five years, the time period in which the Executive Director of the Board of Nursing (Board) must survey each school of nursing in this state and submit a written report to the Board.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will not have an impact on any programs or policies of the Department of Health or the Board of Nursing.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Board of Nursing had an annual surplus of \$1,674,535 in FY17-18, an annual surplus of \$1,362,072 in FY18-19, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$10,934,363 on June 30, 2019.
