**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2615 - SB 2636**

February 18, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Expands the unruly act of illegal use of a communication device by a minor to include transmission, distribution, publication or dissemination of a photograph, video, or other material that contains an image of sexual activity involving a minor.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 37-1-132, if a child is found to be an unruly child, the court is authorized to make such disposition as authorized by Tenn. Code Ann. § 37-1-131(a)(1),(a)(2),(a)(7) or (b); however, no child found to be an unruly child may be placed on probation under the supervision of the Department of Children's Services, unless such child is found to also be delinquent.
- This analysis assumes that the court will order the child to perform community service work pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 37-1-131(a)(7); therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Any impact to the court system is estimated to be not significant.
