FISCAL NOTE

SB 2022 - HB 2650

March 1, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires a temporary healthcare staffing agency doing business in the state to provide notice to the Health Facilities Commission (HFC) identifying its business entity and any controlling person by December 31 of each year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-11-2302(c), temporary healthcare staffing agencies doing business in the state were required to provide notice to the HFC by December 31, 2023.
- Requiring temporary healthcare staffing agencies to provide notice of their operations on an annual basis will not have a significant impact on the operations of the HFC; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
