**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 2657 - SB 2733**

February 14, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires a court to find that it's in the best interest of a minor child to have such child's parent's residential parenting time limited due to the parent's willful abandonment, physical abuse, sexual abuse, or a pattern of emotional abuse of the parent, child, or of another person living with such child.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The courts will not experience an increase in caseloads; therefore, any impact to the court system is estimated to be not significant.
- This legislation will have no significant fiscal impact to state or local government as it pertains to modification of private custody agreements. Any fiscal impact will be borne by private parties.
