FISCAL NOTE

SB 2399 - HB 2663

March 5, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that examples of prohibited weapons for the offense of intentionally or knowingly possessing, manufacturing, transporting, repairing, or selling any other implement for infliction of serious bodily injury or death that has no common lawful purpose include a blackjack and a stun baton.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-1302(f)(4), intentionally or knowingly possessing, manufacturing, transporting, repairing, or selling any other implement for infliction of serious bodily injury or death that has no common lawful purpose is a Class A misdemeanor offense.
- Any impact to local incarceration resulting from specifying a blackjack and a stun baton are examples of prohibited weapons is estimated to be not significant.
