**HB 2707 - SB 2604**

March 5, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the State Board of Education (SBE) and the Department of Education (DOE) to strive to ensure that the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) program curriculum is periodically updated to include the dangers of new forms of substance abuse when they are identified as societal problems.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

- SBE and DOE will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources.
