HB 2716 - SB 2892

February 13, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Effective July 1, 2020, increases, from \$800 to \$1,000, the cash supplement for in-service training for police officers eligible to receive the pay supplement in 2020.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$2,945,000/FY20-21

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 38-8-111(a)(2), a police officer must complete eight months of full-time service as a law enforcement officer during the calendar year and at least 40 hours of in-service training to receive the state cash salary supplement of \$800.
- There are approximately 14,725 law enforcement officers that would be eligible for this cash salary supplement.
- An increase in the cash salary supplement of \$200 (\$1,000 - \$800).
- The proposed legislation will increase the cash supplement only for police officers eligible to receive the pay supplement in 2020.
- An increase in state expenditures in FY20-21 of \$2,945,000 (14,725 x \$200).
