SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires students in grades nine through twelve (9-12) to be taught the virtues of capitalism and the constitutional republic form of government in the United States and Tennessee, as compared to other political and economic systems.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The current academic standards in social studies for grades 9-12 satisfy the requirements of the proposed legislation. Therefore, no new standards will have to be adopted by the State Board of Education. Local education agencies will be able to continue using existing instructional materials.
- Any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
