**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 2590 - HB 2849**

February 8, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Changes, from every seven days to every ten days, the frequency in which the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) is required to electronically notify the National Association of Drug Diversion Investigators (NADDI) of any new persons placed on the Methamphetamine Registry.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-431(1), the TBI, in cooperation with NADDI is required to devise a method to electronically notify NADDI at least every seven days of any person placed on the Methamphetamine Registry.
- Extending this rolling deadline by three days will not significantly impact state expenditures.
