FISCAL NOTE

HB 2961 - SB 2877

March 9, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL: Directs the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR), with the assistance of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI), the District Attorneys General Conference (DAGC), and the Department of Safety (DOS), to study the feasibility of a Shelby County crime lab and the impact of such a crime lab on public health, safety, education, housing, and the economy. Requires TACIR to submit a report disclosing its findings to the General Assembly by January 14, 2025.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures – \$50,000/FY24-25

Assumptions:

- According to TACIR, the commission will need to contract with a subject matter expert to complete the study.
- The estimated increase in state expenditures due to contracting with an outside expert is \$50,000 in FY24-25.
- The TBI, DAGC, and DOS will be able to assist TACIR with the study utilizing existing staff and resources, resulting in no significant increase in state expenditures.
