FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (004845): Proposes amending Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of Tennessee by changing the elections for judicial and other civil officers, except the assessor of property, to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November preceding the expiration of their respective terms of service, beginning with the election of 2030, and by changing the elections for assessors of property to the first Thursday in August, beginning with the election of 2028.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL AS AMENDED:

Increase State Expenditures – \$9,400/FY23-24

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Pursuant to the Constitution of Tennessee, elections for judicial and other civil officers are currently held the first Thursday in August.
- The Secretary of State will publish the proposed amendment.
- The one-time increase in state expenditures in FY23-24 for publishing costs is estimated to be \$9,400 based on the cost of recent publications incurred by the Secretary of State.
- Any increase in state expenditures to prepare a copy of this resolution is estimated to be not significant.
