HJR 683

SUMMARY OF BILL: Urges the State Capitol Commission to require a David Crockett statue or monument to be erected on the State Capitol grounds atop Motlow Tunnel in lieu of the Senator Edward Carmack statue. Requires copies of this resolution be sent to the David Crockett Commission and the State Capitol Commission.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated Title 4, Chapter 8, Part 4 created the David Crockett Commission to identify ways and means and raise the necessary funds to erect a monument or statute honoring David Crockett on the grounds of the State Capitol.
- Urging the State Capitol Commission to require the David Crockett monument or statute be erected atop the Motlow Tunnel will not significantly alter the private funds currently being raised by the David Crockett Commission.
- Any increase in state expenditures to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the specified entities is estimated to be not significant.
