FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 20 - HB 789

March 16, 2021

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires the Department of Health (DOH) to post information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) concerning the health effects and dangers of using vapor products on its website. Further requires the DOH, in coordination with the Department of Education (DOE), to disseminate this information to students in public middle schools, junior high schools, and senior high schools.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

IMPACT TO COMMERCE OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004758): Deletes and rewrites all language after the enacting clause such that the only substantive change removes the requirement that DOH post information from the CDC on its website.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- The DOH and the DOE can accommodate disseminating the required information within existing resources.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Requiring the DOH and the DOE to disseminate such information will not result in any significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
