SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires an officer of elections to designate entrances to the building in which an election is to be held for the use of voters.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-7-101(a) the officer of elections is in charge of and responsible for the conduct of all elections being held at the polling place where such officer is the officer of elections.
- It is assumed that, in general, officers of elections in the state currently provide signage which designate entrances to the buildings in which elections are held; therefore, this legislation is estimated to have no significant impact on state or local government.
