FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 28 - SB 71

February 25, 2019

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires an officer of elections to designate entrances to the building in which an election is to be held for the use of voters.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004742): Deletes and replaces language in the original bill such that the only substantive change directs county election commissions, rather than officers of elections, to designate entrances to the building in which an election is to be held for the use of voters.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 2-7-101(a) the officer of elections is in charge of and responsible for the conduct of all elections being held at the polling place where such officer is the officer of elections.
- Passage of this legislation is not expected to place any significant additional responsibility on county election commissions; therefore, any impact on state or local government is considered not significant.
