SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires county attorneys to consult with and advise elected county officials as to the proper application and enforcement of federal and state laws.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tenn. Code Ann. § 5-6-112 currently authorizes the county mayor to employ or retain counsel to advise the county mayor and county commissioners as to their legal rights as such members, to prepare and draft resolutions for passage by the body, and to represent the county in legal suits.
- The proposed language will not result in any significant fiscal impact to local government.
