FISCAL NOTE

HB 124 - SB 247

February 14, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires each local education agency (LEA) to conduct a survey of its students to ascertain the proportion of students who have home internet access and report this information to the Department of Education (DOE) no later than November 1, 2017. Requires the DOE to prepare a report based on this information and deliver it to the Governor, the House Education Administrative and Planning Committee, and the Senate Education Committee no later than December 15, 2017.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- LEAs will add this question to one of the forms that students must return to the LEA at the beginning of each new academic year. Any increase in local government expenditures is estimated to be not significant.
- This report will be compiled and presented by the DOE without an increase in personnel or a reduction in other expenditures. No fiscal impact on state expenditures.
