FISCAL NOTE

HB 193 - SB 273

February 5, 2017

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires only those administrative judges and hearing officers within the executive branch to attend training conducted by the Department of Human Resources (DHR) within six months of the start of employment.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Under current law, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-5-324, all persons employed as administrative judges and hearing officers are required to attend DHR training.
- Administrative judges and hearing officers within the Department of State will not be required to attend DHR training.
- According to the Department of State, administrative judges and hearing officers within the Department currently receive comparable training from specialized administrative law resources and the proposed law would codify existing practice.
- The provisions of the bill will not result in any significant fiscal impact to state government.
