SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands what may be petitioned to exchange confiscated firearms for to include any equipment suitable for law enforcement purposes.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 39-17-1317(l)(1), the Commissioner of Safety, the Director of the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, the Executive Director of the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission, the executive head of any local law enforcement agency, or the director of a judicial district drug task force is authorized to petition the criminal court or the court in the official's county for permission to exchange firearms that have previously been properly titled to the law enforcement agency or the drug task force for other firearms, ammunition, or body armor suitable for use by the law enforcement agency or drug task force.
- Expanding what is permitted to be petitioned to be exchanged to include equipment suitable for use by an agency will not have a significant fiscal impact on state or local government.
