HB 323 - SB 354

March 12, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Commissioner of the Department of Correction to conduct a study of programs to reduce recidivism that is required to include programs addressing job training, fundamental life skills, and job placement to facilitate the transition of former inmates into the workforce and to report the findings of such study to the General Assembly no later than January 10, 2020.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Correction, a study of gap analysis of existing programs is currently being conducted, and the analysis will identify and report on the items required by the proposed legislation; therefore, any impact to the Department resulting from the proposed legislation is estimated to be not significant.
