SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires persons under 25 years of age to wear a helmet when riding a three-wheeled motorcycle, including autocycles.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 55-9-308, drivers of autocycles are not required to wear crash helmets.
- It is a Class C misdemeanor offense to forgo wearing a crash helmet, except under specific circumstances.
- There will not be enough Class C misdemeanor violations as a result of this legislation to significantly impact state or local government revenue or expenditures.
