SB 413 – HB 952

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates the “Visiting Sports Team Act.” Exempts a physician who is duly qualified to practice medicine under the law of another state from licensure requirements in Tennessee when dealing with a sports team.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Sports teams that do not bring their own physician rely on existing medical professionals on sight at these sporting events.
- Sports teams that do bring their own physician are not taking the steps to become licensed in Tennessee.
- Based on information provided by the Department of Health, the proposed legislation will not have a significant impact on licensure fees; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
