FISCAL NOTE

SB 760 - HB 1039

February 15, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the State Coordinator of Elections to submit, after each decennial reapportionment, a list of registered voters that has been submitted by each county to the Comptroller of the Treasury (COT). Requires the COT to compare such a list to the COT's geographic information system data to ensure that voters have been assigned to the correct congressional, General Assembly, and county governing body districts. Requires the COT to share the results with the county administrator of elections of each county and the State Coordinator of Elections. Requires each county administrator of elections to review the results of the comparison and make the final determination regarding the correct assignment of the registered voter and to share its findings with the State Coordinator of Elections to confirm any misassigned voter.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The COT currently compares lists of registered voters within counties by request, having compared 46 counties by request after the 2020 redistricting cycle.
- Requiring the COT to compare all counties can be accomplished within existing resources and personnel without a significant increase in state expenditures.
- The State Coordinator of Elections and county administrators of elections can accommodate the requirements of this legislation without a significant increase in state or local expenditures.
