SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (005555): Voids a metropolitan government ordinance, resolution, or charter provision that requires a supermajority vote of the local legislative body (LLB) for certain proposals. Requires such votes to be held to the same voting requirements applicable to ordinances of the LLB in general.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL AS AMENDED:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The proposed legislation would prohibit a metropolitan government from requiring a supermajority vote of the LLB for improvements, renovations, or replacements of existing facilities owned by a metropolitan government that are to be used for substantially the same use as prior to the improvement, renovation, or replacement, and would instead require the LLB to vote on such proposals in the same manner as ordinances of the LLB in general.
- Reducing the vote threshold for certain proposals within a metropolitan government would have no significant fiscal impact on state or local government.
- Any subsequent fiscal impacts would be dependent on future votes taken by the LLB and cannot be estimated.
