SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (003501): Creates Quinnlee's Law.

Removes the requirement that a provider of home medical equipment services that has a principal place of business outside this state must maintain an office or place of business within this state. Requires the Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities to establish by rule that a provider of home medical equipment services that has a principal place of business outside this state identify a contact person who must provide the state survey agency and its surveyors access to all survey-related material stored in either physical or electronic format upon demand.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL AS AMENDED:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- The proposed legislation is not estimated to have a significant impact on the number of licensed home medical equipment providers in this state.
- The Board for Licensing Health Care Facilities can promulgate rules and comply with the proposed legislation within existing personnel and resources.
- The proposed legislation will not have a significant impact on the policies or procedures of the Health Facilities Commission; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
