HB 902 - SB 996

April 3, 2019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires local education agencies (LEAs) operating at least one high school to include in the annual report published by the Commissioner of the Department of Education (DOE), information on the number of students that: (1) took college entrance exams for the first and second time; (2) qualified for the Tennessee HOPE Scholarship despite not attaining the required score on the ACT or SAT; and (3) were eligible to receive the Tennessee HOPE scholarship but were ineligible to receive the Tennessee Promise Scholarship.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- DOE, LEAs, the Tennessee Higher Education Commission (THEC), and the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation (TSAC) will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources without a significant increase in expenditures.
- DOE, LEAs, THEC, and TSAC will be able to amend their policies in accordance with the provisions of this legislation during the normal course of business; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- No significant impact to state or local operations.
- No change to the Basic Education Program.
