FISCAL NOTE

SB 1067 - HB 1423

February 14, 2023

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits a government agency from holding a membership in an organization that collaborates with, or is directly or indirectly sponsored by, manufacturers of medical products for which the agency is responsible for creating or implementing state policy. Establishes a violation of such is an unfair and deceptive act or practice under the *Consumer Protection Act of 1977*.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Any increase in the number of complaints handled by the Attorney General is estimated to be not significant and can be handled by existing staff during normal work hours.
- Committing an unfair or deceptive practice under the *Consumer Protection Act of 1977* is a Class B misdemeanor offense.
- There will not be a sufficient number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any impact to commerce or jobs in Tennessee is estimated to be not significant.
