**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1127 - SB 1131**

March 4, 2023

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the operation of all-terrain and off-highway vehicles on a certain section of State Route 330 in Oliver Springs during the hours of daylight for the entirety of the year, rather than for two weekends per year. Specifies that such authorization does not require a local legislative body's reapproval.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Authorizing the operation of all-terrain and off-highway vehicles on the relevant stretch of State Route 330 in Oliver Springs all year-round, rather than for only two weekends per year, is not estimated to impact the number of violations for unauthorized use of all-terrain or off-highway vehicles.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
