# FISCAL NOTE

HB 1464 - SB 1250

March 17, 2023

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires any law enforcement agency that investigates a violation regarding critical infrastructure vandalism to submit a report to the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI). Requires the TBI to compile all reports received from law enforcement agencies statewide and submit quarterly reports to all Members of the General Assembly.

Authorizes the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency (TEMA) to promulgate rules establishing minimum security requirements for critical infrastructure, to the extent not preempted by federal law.

Requires a fire department, law enforcement agency, or other governmental agency that responds to or investigates a fire at a facility located in this state where food intended to be introduced into commerce is processed, to submit a report to the State Fire Marshal (SFM). Requires the SFM to compile all reports received from such entities and submit quarterly reports to all Members of the General Assembly.

## Assumptions:

- The various law enforcement agencies, fire departments, and other government agencies, to which this legislation applies, can provide reports to the either the TBI or SFM utilizing existing resources.
- The TBI and SFM can compile reports and submit comprehensive quarterly reports to Members of the General Assembly utilizing existing resources.
- The TEMA can promulgate rules to establish minimum security requirements for critical infrastructure utilizing existing resources.
