SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from \$250 to \$1,000, the aggregate amount a group can receive or contribute to support or oppose any candidate for public office within a calendar year to be considered a political campaign committee and also removes certain groups from being considered a political campaign committee.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Redefines what groups constitute a political campaign committee as overseen by the Tennessee Bureau of Ethics and Campaign Finance (TBECF).
- The TBECF will need to update manuals and their website to reflect the change; however, such changes can be performed with existing staff and will not result in any increase to state expenditures.
