SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the list of animals designated as official state pets to include any other animal, instead of dogs and cats only, adopted from Tennessee animal shelters and rescues.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumption:

- Designating all other animals, in addition to dogs and cats, adopted from Tennessee animal shelters and rescues as official state pets will not result in increased printing costs. Therefore, the impact to state government is not significant.
