HB 1786 - SB 1742

SUMMARY OF BILL: Specifies that all proposals for solicitation of goods or services and related records are available for public inspection only after the completion of evaluation by the state.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- This legislation clarifies the purpose of Tenn. Code Ann. § 10-7-504(a)(7), which currently requires proposals received pursuant to personal service, professional service, and consultant service contract regulations, and related records, to be available for public inspection only after the completion of evaluation of same by the state. Therefore, there will be no significant impact on state government operations.
