**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1865 – SB 1828**

January 25, 2020

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Restores consideration for expunction of misdemeanor fraudulent use of a credit card or debit card (up to \$500) on or after November 1, 1989.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-32-101(g)(1)(B), a person who commits certain crimes is authorized to petition the court for expunction.
- Public Chapter 200 (2019) removed application fees for applying for expunction; therefore, any increase in petitions for expunctions will not result in a significant fiscal impact to state revenue.
- Any increase in workload to the courts can be accomplished within existing resources.
