FISCAL NOTE

SB 1914 - HB 2241

February 28, 2018

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the state forester to designate portions or all of each state forest as a free-use area where residents of the state may harvest dead timber for personal use. Requires the state forester to promulgate rules for harvesting dead timber in free-use areas, which must be approved by the Commissioner of the Department of Agriculture.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact the policies and operations of the state forester or the Department of Agriculture. Any impact on the state forester or the Department of Agriculture relative to promulgating rules can be accommodated within existing resources.
