SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires, by July 1, 2021, each hospital with surgical services, and each ambulatory surgical treatment center, operating in this state to adopt and implement a policy that prevents human exposure to surgical smoke by the use of a surgical smoke evacuation system during any planned surgical procedure that is likely to generate surgical smoke.
