FISCAL NOTE

HB 2150 – SB 2133

February 11, 2020

SUMMARY OF BILL: Effective January 2, 2021, deletes a statutory provision requiring the Tennessee Advisory Commission on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR) to conduct a study and deliver a report on broadband deployment to members of the General Assembly.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 13-24-413, TACIR is required to conduct a study and deliver a report on broadband deployment to members of the General Assembly by January 1, 2021.
- The proposed language will delete the provision on January 2, 2021.
- As the report on the study is required to be delivered the previous day, there will be no significant fiscal impact to state or local government.

IMPACT TO COMMERCE:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Deleting a provision requiring TACIR to conduct a study the day after such study is delivered to the General Assembly will not result in any significant impact to jobs or commerce in Tennessee.
