### FISCAL NOTE

SB 2204 - HB 2659

February 10, 2022

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires that all contracts entered into by the Megasite Authority of West Tennessee (MAWT) be approved by the State Building Commission (SBC).

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

#### **NOT SIGNIFICANT**

#### Assumptions:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 4-15-102 authorizes the SBC to approve and supervise:
  - o Any improvement to real property in which any state entity has an interest; and
  - All contracts for the improvement of real property or the demolition of any structure on real property in which any state entity has an interest.
- Tennessee Code Annotated § 64-9-112 provides that a lease of real property, and all amendments thereto, entered into by the MAWT and all capital grants and corresponding agreements are subject to approval by the SBC.
- The proposed legislation would require the following to be reviewed and approved by the SBC:
  - o Any improvement to be constructed by a third party;
  - o A sublease by a third party; and
  - Any action taken by the MAWT or a lessee pursuant to a lease previously approved by the SBC.
- Requiring such contracts to be approved by the SBC is consistent with other statutory
  duties of the SBC; therefore, any impact to state or local government is estimated to be
  not significant.
