FISCAL NOTE

SB 2214 - HB 2475

February 10, 2022

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits any disposal of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) surplus property from occurring by public auction or sale under sealed bid until 30 or more days have passed from the date notice is first posted on the internet.

Prohibits any TWRA employee, immediate family of the employee, and someone working on an employee's behalf, from purchasing surplus property from the TWRA; however, such non-employees may purchase such surplus property for their own use. Authorizes the executive director of the TWRA to terminate the employment of an employee who violates this prohibition.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- This legislation may prevent employees of the TWRA from receiving real or conceived preferential treatment regarding the disposal of surplus TWRA property; however, any impact on the sale value of properties is estimated to be not significant.
- This legislation will not have a significant impact on the amount of surplus TWRA property available for sale in this state.
- Any fiscal impact on state or local government will be not significant.
