SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes members of the controlled substances database committee to attend meetings via videoconferencing and be counted present for purposes of detecting a quorum.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Health (DOH), the proposed legislation will not have a significant impact on the procedures and processes of the DOH or the health related boards; therefore, any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-29-121, all health related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. The Boards had an annual surplus of \$4,526,956 in FY15-16, an annual surplus of \$3,551,254 in FY16-17, and a cumulative reserve balance of \$32,645,083 on June 30, 2017.
