SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) to report the results of criminal background checks to the authorized requesting persons and entities within five business days of completing the search.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 38-6-109(a), the TBI must process requests for criminal background checks from any authorized persons, organizations, or entities permitted by law to seek criminal history background checks on certain persons, pursuant to a format and under procedures as it may require.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 38-6-109(b)(2), upon completion of the search, the bureau shall report its findings to the requesting persons, organizations, or entities authorized by law to receive such information.
- The proposed legislation requires the TBI to report these findings within five business days of completing the search.
- The TBI can report the results of criminal background checks to authorized requesting persons and entities within five days of completing the search within existing bureau resources.
- Any fiscal impact to state or local government is estimated to be not significant.
