FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1038 – SB 2418

March 23, 2018

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Exempts, from the firing range and classroom hour requirements to obtain a handgun carry permit, anyone who in the five years preceding the date of application has successfully completed the Department of Correction firearms qualification.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015902):** Deletes and replaces all language after the enacting clause such that the only substantive change changes the effective date from upon becoming to law to January 1, 2019.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Based on information provided by the Department of Safety, the provisions of the legislation are not expected to impact revenue derived from the issuance of handgun carry permits or expenditures associated with issuance of such permits.
- The fiscal impact of this legislation is estimated to be not significant.
