SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Tennessee Ethics Commission's (Commission) annual ethics course for supervisory personnel in the executive branch of state government be provided electronically and to include laws on lobbying.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 3-6-112(a), the Commission is required to provide an annual ethics course concerning laws administered and enforced by the Commission for supervisory personnel in the executive branch.
- The Commission currently provides the training electronically on its website. Adding laws on lobbying to the training will not result in any significant fiscal impact to the Commission.
- No significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
