**SB 2450 - HB 2573**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Declares arbitration agreement provisions that have the purpose or effect of concealing the details relating to claims of sexual harassment or sexual assault to be void and unenforceable, and contrary to the public policy of State of Tennessee.
