HB 2681 - SB 2542

SUMMARY OF BILL: Allows a patient who suffers from long-term chronic pain, as defined by the Department of Health in rule, to receive a prescription for opioids or benzodiazepines in quantities up to a 90-day supply if deemed appropriate by the patient's prescriber.
