FISCAL NOTE

HB 2588 - SB 2686

March 2, 2022

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires the General Assembly to transmit to the Governor any joint resolution passed that determines a federal law, rule, or executive order unconstitutional. Requires the Governor to then consult with the Attorney General and Reporter (AG) to determine the constitutionality of the law, rule, or order. Authorizes the Governor to nullify the law, rule, or order rendering it unenforceable within this state if the AG believes the law, rule, or order to be unconstitutional.

FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- The General Assembly, Governor, and AG will be able to comply with the requirements of this legislation within existing resources; any impact to state government is not significant.
